

PACKAGING GUIDELINES

- Use enough cushioning material for delicate items.
- Check the thickness of the cardboard packaging being used. As a note, reused cardboard boxes are weaker and should only be used for durable items.
- Place fragile goods at the center of the packaging ALWAYS. Use enough padding and bubble wrap to keep them in place.
- If more than one fragile item is included, wrap them individually in bubble wrap before putting them in a bigger packaging.
- Edges and pointy ends should be well protected.
- Wrap rolled items, such as carpets, in foil to preserve it.
- Liquid items should be packaged in leak-proof containers.
